monday

Pray that the GBU and its students remain founded on the word. That they'd seek to understand, celebrate and defend the truth of the gospel (1st value of the GBU).

Pray that, motivated by grace, students would worship God for the gospel and that they'd love each other and the lost (2nd value of the GBU). Pray for students reaching out on campuses this week in Brussels.

Pray the GBU would persevere in discipleship, encouraging and equipping students in the faith for a life of godliness and mission (4th of GBU's 6 values). Pray for the Grill a Christian event in Brussels this evening.

Pray God would grow Christian students as disciples of Jesus during their studies (2nd goal of the GBU).

tuesday

Thank God for the way GBU students are working together in order to give as many students as possible the opportunity to hear and respond to the gospel of Jesus Christ! Pray they persevere in the mission, being strengthened by God Himself.

Pray students would understand the vision of GBU clearly so that they would benefit from its ministry without replacing their church with it.

Pray for the Bible study prep meeting taking place tonight for student who will be leading studies on Colossians. Pray we can sharpen each other, and we would approach God's word humbly, with rigour and in total dependence on God.

Thank God for the evangelistic events that have been held since the start of term. Pray He continues to work in the heart of those who have heard the gospel and that he would give them repentance and faith.

Pray the GBU would remain active in evangelism whilst proclaiming Christ crucified and resurrected faithfully, pertinently and attractively (3rd value of the GBU).

Pray that the GBU & its students would be resolved to be united around the essential truths of the gospel (5th value of the GBU).

Thank God for all the students who are taking on responsibilities this year. Pray they'd grow in faith and service, and that God would give wisdom to those who are following them.

saturday
