## monday

Pray for the GBU's interns who will be presenting exams next weeks: that they would be further encouraged, rooted in Christ & equipped for a life of service of God & his church.

Thank God for the biblical vision of the GBU, and pray the Board and the staff GBU remain faithful to the gospel. Pray for the Board's meeting tonight: that God would give them wisdom to make decisions which contribute to the advancement of the gospel.

Pray God would grow Christian students as disciples of Jesus during their studies (2nd goal of GBU).

Pray God would send new interns & one more worker to the GBU for September 2019: the harvest is plentiful but the labourers are few (currently 1.5 full-time)!

## tuesday

Thank God for the many blessings He has poured out onto students in 2018 and for His support through their trials. Pray 2019 would be a year of growth for them in the Lord.

Pray that, motivated by grace, students would worship God for the gospel and that they'd love each other and the lost (2nd value of GBU).

Pray a good number of students would join the GBU this upcoming term, and those who are Christians would be bold, faithful and filled with love as they open their mouths to speak of Christ.

Pray for Christian students who feel alone and isolated in their faith. Pray they'd be able to join a GBU group or other believers in order to be encouraged and supported in the faith.

Pray the GBU & its students would always be dedicated to the local church which is the main place of growth and service of believers (6th value of GBU).

## wednesday

Pray God would strengthen and motivate believing students in the gospel so they would announce it faithfully amongst their fellow students (1st goal of GBU).

Pray that, soon, a GBU group would be able to start in Liège thanks to the ministry of a new GBU-worker so that more students would be supported in their mission of disciples who make disciples.

Pray Christian students keep their conduct honorable before everyone during exams out of fear of God. Pray they'd work hard for God's glory, putting their studies into the perspective of their eternity.

Thank God for the love of the supporters of the GBU towards students which flows from their faith and manifests itself in their prayers and their financial & moral support. Pray this partnership would strengthen and grow.

Pray for the activities of the existing groups which will soon resume: for commitment to groups & their growth in maturity & number.

## thursday

Pray for KFS Denmark who would like to pioneer student ministry at Greenland's only university in Nuuk. Ask for more people to join the team.

Pray the GBU would remain active in evangelism whilst proclaiming Christ crucified and resurrected faithfully, pertinently and attractively (3rd value of GBU).

Pray the GBU would persevere in discipleship, encouraging and equipping students in the faith for a life of godliness and mission (4th value of GBU).

Praise God for the freedom that students have in Liège to share the gospel. Pray they'd make the most of it, strengthened by Him to share it with more than 44,000 non-Christian students.

Pray for the organisation of Hérauts 2019 (09/02). Pray that many students would attend, and that, through it, they would be motivated by God's great compassion to persevere boldly in their mission as disciple-makers.

## friday

Pray for the staff of the GBU. Pray that they'd be able to make progress on various fronts whilst students are in exams, and for energy for the new term starting in 1 month.

Thank God for the opportunities some GBU-students have had to read the Bible with non-Christian students. Pray God would give repentance and faith to A., A., B. and T.

Pray God would continue to work in the hearts of A., O., J., C. & D. who came to Christmas outreach events. Pray He gives them a spiritual hunger that pushes them to want to know more about Jesus, and that the GBU-students would persevere in their outreach.

Pray students would be able to rest well during the holidays and be refreshed & nourished by God's word, whilst continuing to serve others. Pray they'd be able to resume the mission on their campus in February, being strengthened by Him.

## saturday

Pray that HERAUTS, (see www.herauts.com), would be helpful many churches. Pray God would use it so that students would be more resolved & equipped to fulfill the mission Jesus gave to his church (Mt 28:18-20).

Thank God for the support students have from their church and pray these would continue to encourage them in the Truth so that they'd be firmly rooted in Christ and equipped for a life of daily service & mission.

Thank God for the faithful churches that the students are part of, and for the leaders He gave these churches to equip the saints for the work of ministry (Eph 4:11-16). Pray these churches take good care of them.

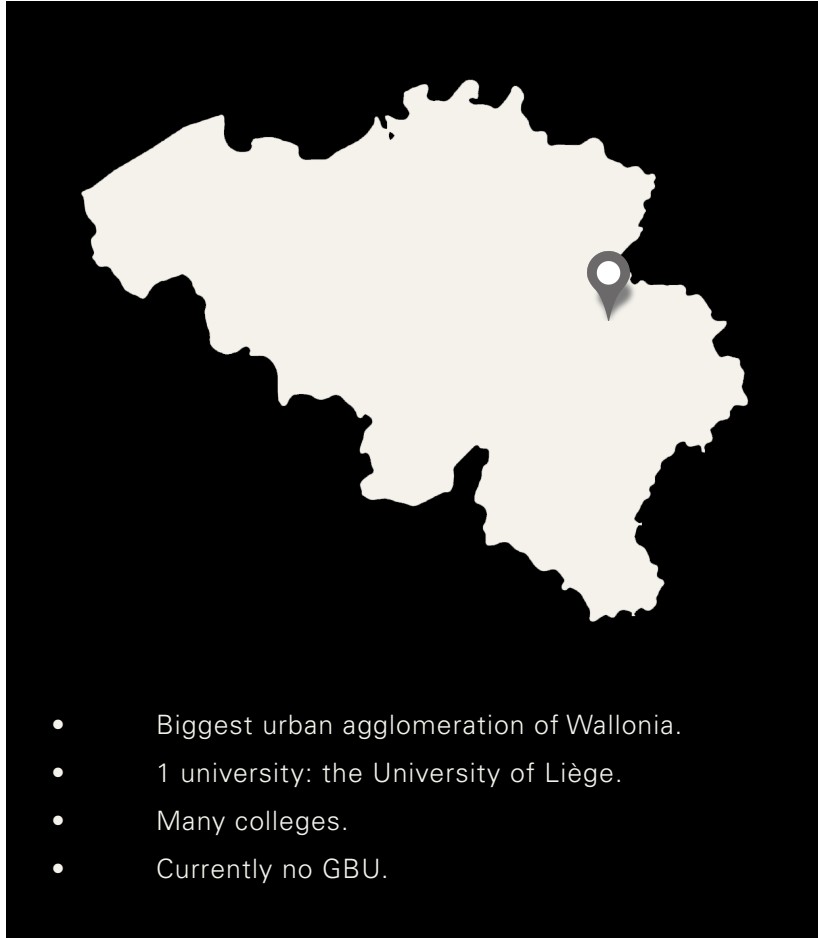
