monday

Pray that God would strengthen and motivate students by the gospel so that they proclaim it faithfully amongst their fellow students (1st goal of the GBU).

Pray many freshers starting their studies in September would hear about the GBU, and that more students would benefit from our ministry so that they persevere in the faith and in their mission as disciple-making disciples.

Pray God would grow Christian students as disciples of Jesus during their studies (2nd goal of the GBU).

thursday

Thank God for the great questions asked at the "Grill a Christian" event in Brussels on 06/05. Pray God would continue his work in their hearts and give them repentance and faith in Jesus.

Thank God for the GBU's positive impact amongst students in Mons over the last decades and for the people He used. Pray the GBU would continue to have a positive impact in this city in the coming years in the areas of evangelism, edification and training of students.

Pray the GBU would remain active in evangelism whilst proclaiming Christ crucified and resurrected faithfully, pertinently and attractively (3rd value of the GBU).

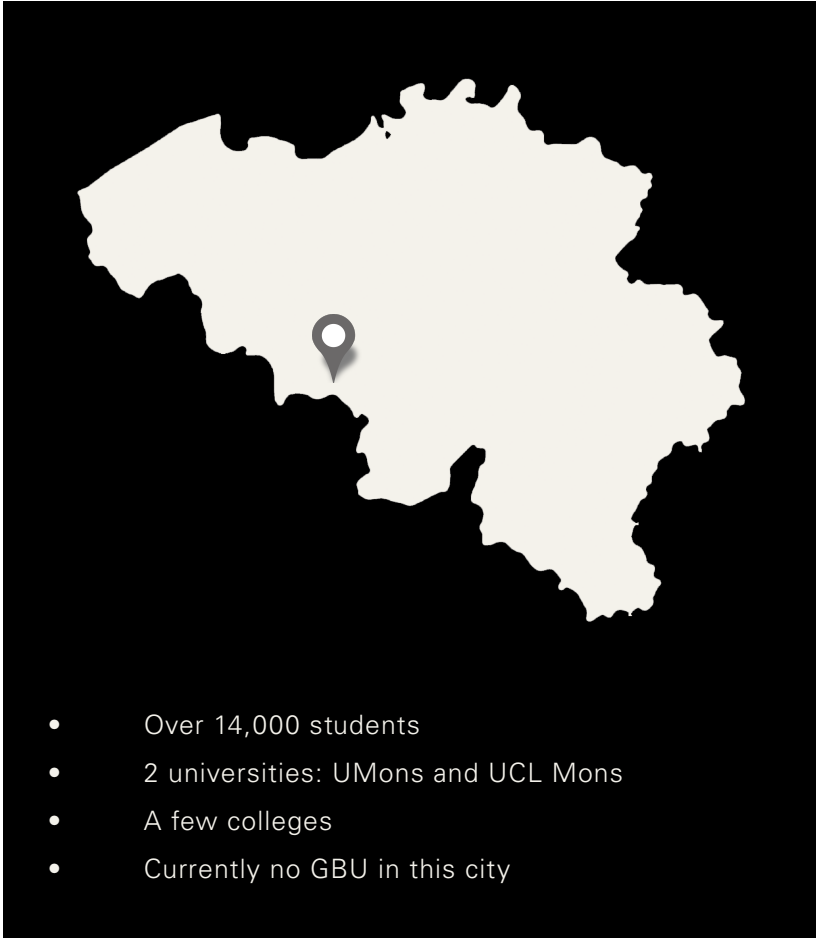
