monday

Thank God for the apprentices who will be spending this year serving the GBU. Pray it would be a year of growth for them (in faith & service), and pray for those who will be following them. Pray God would use them all in his harvest field.

Pray the GBU would remain active in evangelism whilst proclaiming Christ crucified and resurrected faithfully, pertinently and attractively (3rd value of GBU). Pray God enables students to do this during the welcome weeks.

Thank God for the positive impact GBU has had amongst students in Liège over the past decades, and for all those who served them. Pray the GBU would continue to have a positive impact in the coming years in evangelism, edification and training of students.

Thank God for the new students who have committed to lead groups this year. Pray they'd grow in faith & service, and that God would give wisdom to those who will follow them.

tuesday

Praise God for his sovereignty and utter control over the coronavirus pandemic, and pray He gives wisdom to the GBU to persevere in the mission amongst thousands of students who desperately need to hear the gospel of Jesus!

Please pray for us as we organise the welcome events that will take place in Brussels from 14th to 25th September. Pray many students would join the GBU in a safe environment.

Pray that the training our Relay-workers will follow would help them grow in maturity, shape their convictions (more and more faithful to the Bible), and push them to share God's word more whilst relying on the Spirit's work.

Pray God gives wisdom to our local authorities, here in Belgium, as they continue to manage the Covid-19 crisis. Pray they have a concern for the well-being of all, and that the gospel can be freely sown without too many restrictions.

wednesday

Thank God for the love of GBU-supporters for students which manifests itself in their prayers and their financial & moral support. Pray this partnership which is key and often behind the scenes would be strong and would grow.

Pray the GBU would persevere in discipleship, encouraging and equipping students in the faith for a life of godliness and mission (4th value of GBU). Pray all GBU-workers would have this concern!

At this time of year many AFES Australia student group leaders will hand over to their successors. Pray for good transition and for God's wisdom for the new leadership.

Pray for the GBU we are seeking to start again in Liège this term. Pray we find students who are motivated and whom the staff of GBU can support in their mission in this city.

thursday

Pray for KFS (CUs in Denmark) who will be welcoming around 50 students to a training conference in order to equip and motivate them to reach out with the gospel this term. Pray God uses them for the salvation of many!

Praise God for the two very first Relay-workers GBU is welcoming this year (Amandine & Pierre). Pray for them as they find their feet and adapt to their roles as servants in training. Pray they support the students well.

Pray for H, a student in a sensitive country in East Asia who has recently come to faith. Ask for opportunities to connect with other Christians in her new city.

Pray that the GBU & its students would be resolved to be united in the essential truths of the gospel (5th value of GBU). Pray each person involved in GBU would discern what is central to the gospel and what isn't, in order to work together in unity!

friday

Pray a good number of students would get involved in the GBU in Brussels and in Liège (including student leaders), in order to persevere together in the faith & in their mission of disciple-making disciples.

Thank God for the biblical vision of the GBU, and pray that the Board, the director and staff of the GBU remain faithful and dependent on God in all things so that the gospel would continue to spread amongst students.

Pray for Christian students who feel alone. Pray they'd be committed to their local church, and that they'd be able to join a GBU in order to persevere in the faith and in the mission on their campus.

Pray our Relay-workers would be able to raise all the funds they are missing, in order to be able to finish their year of training and service with the GBU.

saturday

Pray God would strengthen and motivate students by the gospel so they would announce it faithfully amongst their fellow students (1st goal of GBU), even during these strange times. Pray they are creative whilst respecting restrictions.

Pray that, motivated by grace, students would worship God for the gospel and that they'd love each other and the lost (2nd value of GBU). Pray they'd find concrete ways of doing this, in the particular circumstances in which they find themselves.

Pray that, as the academic year starts, the work of the GBU would be more known thanks to all of the flyers handed out and the contacts made during the freshers week, and in other ways so that more students would hear about Jesus and follow him.

Praise God for the freedom that students have in Liège to share the gospel. Pray they'd be strengthened by Him to share it all around them (> 44,000 students in Liège) whilst depending on His power (1 Cor 1:18-25, 2:1-16).

sunday

Pray God would equip students through the GBU & their churches so that they communicate the gospel better on a daily basis to their generation which knows the Bible and its central truths much less than previous generations.

Thank God for the faithful churches that the students are part of and for the leaders he gave these churches to equip the saints for the work of ministry (Eph 4:11-16). Pray students would be committed to their churches.

Pray the students would respect those who labour to teach them, who are over them in the Lord and admonish them in their church. Pray they'd esteem them very highly in love because of their work (1 Thes 5:12-13).

Pray the GBU & its students would always be dedicated to the local church which is the main place of growth and service of believers (6th value of GBU). Pray for more solid, long term partnerships between the GBU and local churches.
