October

monday

Pray for the bible study in Brussels tonight and in Liege tomorrow. Pray God would work in the GBU students through Galatians, and that there would be non-Christians present who would start to understand who Jesus is. Pray for friendships between GBU-students.

Pray for the GBU meeting this evening in Brussels and tomorrow evening in Liège. Pray God would open the eyes of the GBU students and non-Christians present to understand the Gospel and to (continue to) put their faith in Him.

Pray the GBU would remain active in evangelism whilst proclaiming Christ crucified and resurrected faithfully, pertinently and attractively (3rd value of the GBU).

Pray Christian students would study conscientiously, whilst putting their studies into perspective in the light of eternity and what matters the most for themselves & those around them (Mk 2:1-17).

tuesday

Pray the GBU would persevere in discipleship, encouraging and equipping students in the faith for a life of godliness and mission (4th value of the GBU).

Pray that God would strengthen and motivate students by the gospel so that they proclaim it faithfully amongst their fellow students (1st goal of the GBU).

Thank the Lord for the meetings that can take place every Monday and Tuesday evening in Brussels and Liege, even during these uncertain times. Pray that God would continue to use these moments to reveal his glory.

Thank God for the apprentices who are spending this year serving at GBU. Pray it would be a year of growth for them (in the faith & service), and pray for those who will be following them. Pray God would use them all in his harvest field.

wednesday

Pray students would understand the vision of the GBU clearly so that they would benefit from its ministry without replacing their church with it.

Praise God for the freedom Christians have to share the gospel in Belgium. Pray that students would make the most of it, strengthened by Him to share it with more than 170,000 non-Christian students who need to hear and believe in the gospel.

Pray for Alexandre and Sara Manlow (the current staff of GBU): for their family to be firmly built on the Rock, that God would keep them from the devil's attacks, and that they'd be examples in their faith for the students they serve.

Pray for the preparatory study happening this evening for the students who lead the discussions on Galatians. May we sharpen each other and approach God's word with humility, rigour, and dependence on God.

thursday

Pray the GBU & its students would always be dedicated to the local church which is the main place of growth and service of believers (6th value of the GBU).

Thank God for the partnership that exists between the GBU and a few churches. Pray for a strong partnership between local churches and the GBU, knowing that we aim to serve them in supporting their students.

Pray that the GBU & its students remain founded on the word: that they'd seek to understand, celebrate and defend the truth of the gospel (1st value of the GBU).

Pray Christian students keep their conduct honorable before everyone during this semester, out of fear of God. Pray they'd work hard for God's glory, putting their studies into the perspective of their eternity.

friday

Give thanks with IVCF South Korea for Unification Prayer Week - an annual week of prayer where staff and students pray for North Korea and peace on the Korean peninsula.

Ask God for wisdom for IFES senior leaders as they make decisions in response to the constantly changing Coronavirus situation.

Pray for the World Student Day, and those who will be praying during the next 48 hours. Pray that God would give them joy to know they are not alone, and strengthen their faith and their proclamation of the Good News.

Thank God for the good work of many gospel-workers amongst students these last years. Pray God would sustain them and make the students they serve persevere in the faith and in their mission of making Christ known to the lost.

Thank God for all the support of individuals & churches (their prayers, and financial & moral support). Pray for sustained & increased support so that our ministry would bear much fruit.

saturday

Thank God for the GBU which is now in Liege. Pray God strengthens and roots even more these new GBU-members in the faith, and that His Kingdom would grow through their witness in this city.

Pray that the GBU & its students would be resolved to be united around the essential truths of the gospel (5th value of the GBU).

Pray for the GBU day away in Liege today: for lots of fun, for deeper friendships, and for the edification & training of students in God's word.

Pray God would grow Christian students as disciples of Jesus during their studies (2nd goal of the GBU).

Pray that, motivated by grace, students would worship God for the gospel and that they'd love each other and the lost (2nd value of the GBU).

sunday

Thank God for the elders/pastors of your church. Pray God sustains those who are facing particularly tough trials.

Thank God for the faithful churches that the students are part of and for the leaders he gave these churches to equip the saints for the work of ministry (Eph 4:11-16). Pray students would be committed to their churches.

Pray Christian students would rejoice in being part of the church, the Body of Christ, and that they would be committed to it knowing they are members who are called to serve the Body and who have responsibilities towards the other members (1 Co 12).

Thank God for the elders/pastors of the churches students are part of, and pray they'd keep a close watch on themselves and the teaching. Pray students would not despise them, convinced of the importance of their work (1 Tm 4:12-16).

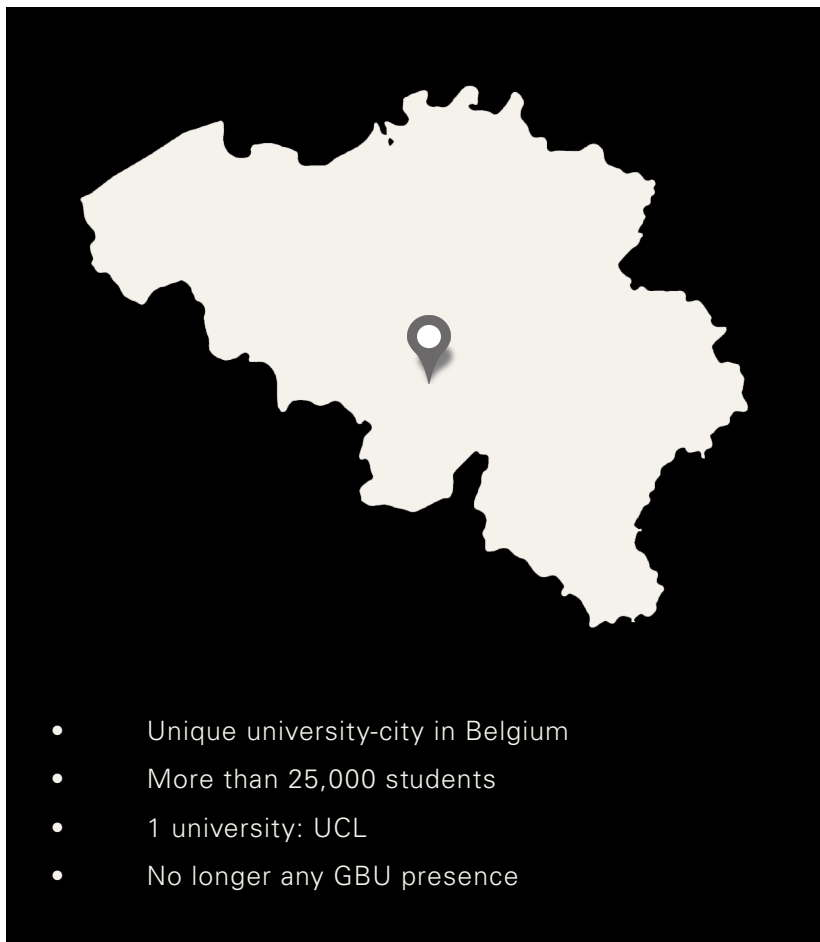
