## monday

Pray for the GBU/IFES group in Naples (Italy): give thanks to God that the students, faced by the challenge of covid-19, are learning to put all their hope in Christ and not in temporary worldly solutions

Pray for the students of Brussels and Liège who've understood the gospel, that they might learn the implications of the gospel as they serve within their local churches.

Pray for this evening's GBU event (on Zoom), a Bible study on Galatians 2:1-14 : proof that Paul's gospel is from God. Pray for both groups that are meeting this evening, the one from Brussels and the one from Liège.

Please pray for tonight's Bible study on Galatians 2:15-21 : We are justified by faith in Jesus and not by our works. Pray for both groups that will be on Zoom (one from Brussels and the other one from Liège).

Pray for the IFES groups in Moldova : several students are working to produce some online evangelistic resources - pray that the contents would be faithful to the Bible and would in no way dilute the scandal of the cross.

## tuesday

Pray for all the one-to-one Bible studies that will take place this week.

Give thanks to God for the Bible studies in Galatians so far this term; pray for discernment as the students hear 'messages' that people say come from God but that aren't the gospel according to the Bible.

Please pray for the Christian students in their studies: may they be able to understand what they need to understand, and may they learn to do everything as for the Lord (Col 3:24).

Praise God for the technology we have (internet, Zoom, smartphones...) that enables students to get involved in the GBU ministry despite the current health crisis!

## wednesday

Pray for the 4 Relay trainees: that God would equip them for a lifetime of service of others, to build up the body of Christ and reach out with the gospel.

Please could you pray for Mustapha, one of the leaders of the IFES group in Burkina Faso: that he would be able to continue his ministry training in order to be a faithful minister of the gospel.

Let's pray that the Christian students would be a blessing to each other, that God would enable them to live in love, following Christ's example (Eph 5:2).

Pray that God would work in the hearts of the students - that they would see themselves as sinners deserving nothing (like the prodigal son) and would know the most extraordinary joy of being declared right in Christ (Phil 3.9)!

## thursday

Pray for those who've heard the gospel's call during the events so far this year and via chats with a Christian student; may the word find deep roots and bear much fruit.

Please pray for perseverance through this trial of covid-19 as it drags on for over six months now; may the students find in God their refuge.

Pray that the gospel - the Word of his grace (Acts 20.32) - would remain at the heart of what the GBU are doing.

Give thanks to God for the Christian hope - yes "as for us, our citizenship is in heaven, from where we await as Saviour the Lord Jesus Christ" (Phil 3:20).

## friday

Pray for the testimony of Christian students: that they would walk in a manner worthy of the gospel, distinct in their attachment to Christ (Eph 4:1).

13 Please pray for Alex and Sara Manlow who head up the GBU groups for French-speaking Belgium : pray the Lord would strengthen them as a couple, as parents, and that their lives would be living sacrifices to God, in response to his mercies (Rom 12:1).

Give thanks to God for a happy GBU day last month, as the students from both Liège and Brussels gathered altogether for a day of teaching and fun. Give thanks for the teaching on what is worship - may it bear much fruit in the lives of the students.

Please pray that the churches in French-speaking Belgium would be faithful in preaching God's Word and living by it week after week, in the knowledge of God's grace.

## saturday

Give thanks for the international day of prayer last month and those who were able to participate; pray too for the small prayer groups that are happening every other week (via Zoom for the time being).

Please do pray for the students who might be struggling in various ways (loneliness, battling with a particular sin, fears, hardship in their studies, lack of motivation...). May the Lord God be their refuge and strength (Ps 46).

Pray the Lord of the harvest to open a door in order for the mission week planned for March 2021 to take place, despite the unknowns with regards to covid-19.

Please could you pray for great wisdom in organising one or several evangelistic events around Christmas, according to what will be allowed by the authorities.

## sunday

Give thanks to our God for a great start to the year and the good momentum He has brought about in both GBU groups (one in Brussels and the other in Liège) since September.

Pray for the church gatherings (online at present, sadly) for the churches in the French-speaking half of Belgium and in Brussels: may God receive all praise, may the church grow as His people progress in Christian maturity, through God's Word.

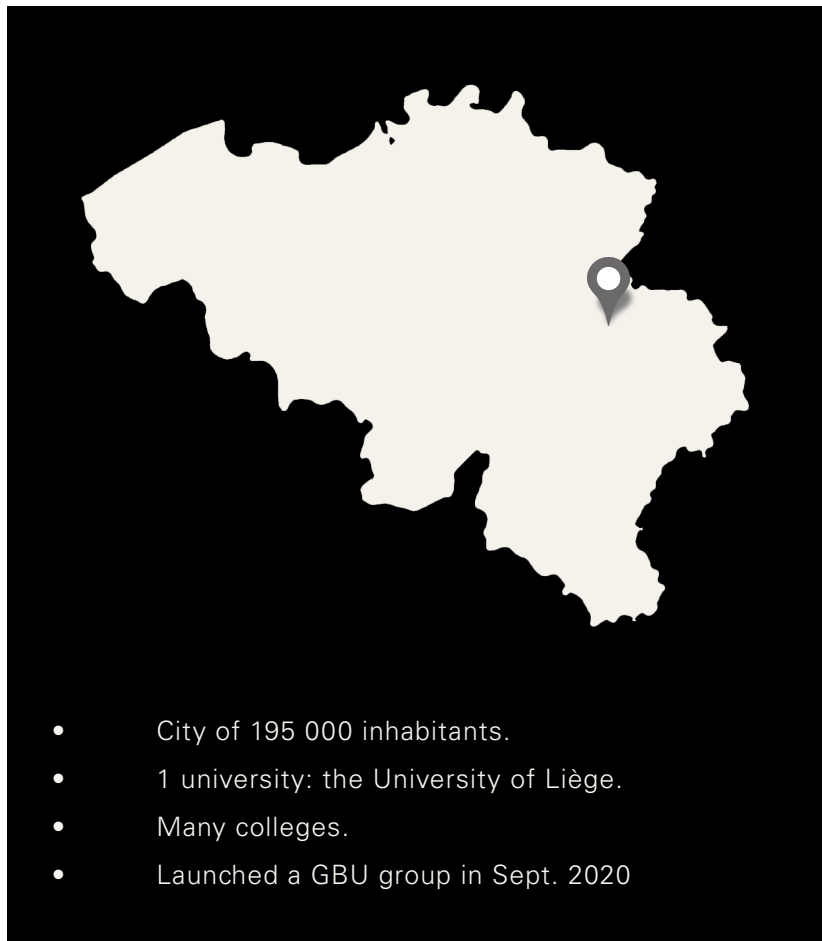
Pray for Alexandre Manlow (the general secretary of the GBU movement) who is preaching this morning at a church in Wavre, Belgium.
