monday

Give thanks to God for the Bible studies in Galatians so far this year; pray for discernment as the students hear 'messages' that people claim come from God but that aren't the true gospel. Pray also for tonight's study on Ga 3:15-4:7.

Pray that, motivated by grace, students would worship God for the gospel and that they'd love each other and the lost (2nd value of the GBU).

Pray for the prayer life of Christian students (and ours!), during this particular time, post-lockdown or of prolonged lockdown. Pray we'd learn to become real prayer-warriors, like Ephraim (Col 4:12-13).

Pray as our mission week starts today, and all the events that will take place. May the Lord open a door for the Word, call souls to himself, and may we work passionately and depending utterly on Him, for his glory!

Thank the Lord for the mission week and for all the students who discovered the gospel. Pray for tonight's Q&A. Pray students would find answers to some important remaining questions, and also for a good follow-up.

tuesday

Pray the GBU would remain active in evangelism whilst proclaiming Christ crucified and resurrected faithfully, pertinently and attractively (3rd value of the GBU).

Thank the Lord for the love of GBU's supporters towards the students which stems from their faith and is manifested in their prayers, financial gifts, and moral support. Pray for this partnership. Pray that they persevere in the faith and their own testimony.

Pray that God would strengthen and motivate students by the gospel so that they proclaim it faithfully, including next week during our mission week (1st goal of the GBU).

Praise God for Christ's resurrection that gives us a certain hope that means that our faith, our life lived out for Jesus and our outreach are not in vain, however difficult they may be (1 Co 15)!

Pray the GBU & its students would always be dedicated to the local church which is the main place of growth and service of believers (6th value of the GBU).

wednesday

Thank the Lord for the great work of the evangelism week committee (22-28/03). Pray for creative ideas for events that would attract many people despite the constraints of Covid and social distancing.

Pray that the pandemic might contribute towards the progress of the gospel (Phil 1:12), especially during our upcoming mission week (22-28/03). May the Lord enable us to make the most of technologies to reach many students, for their salvation and His glory.

Pray for the GBU groups in Brussels & Liège. Pray more Christian students would get involved in order to be encouraged to persevere in the faith & in their mission of disciple-making disciples. So many students desperately need to hear the gospel (Eph 2:1-10)!

Pray that the GBU & its students remain founded on the word. That they'd seek to understand, celebrate and defend the truth of the gospel, including during our mission week (1st value of the GBU).

Pray for tonight's preparation study that aims to equip the students who will be leading studies on Galatians 5 and 6. Pray they would prepare their studies diligently and prayerfully, in order to faithfully share God's word.

thursday

Pray for the GBU/IFES group in Naples (Italy): give thanks to God that the students, faced by the challenge of covid-19, are learning through their Bible studies to put all their hope in Christ and not in temporary worldly solutions

Thank the Lord that he continues to grow groups in Ireland by the use of tools such as Uncover Mark and Uncover John. Pray that the Gospel would be shared a lot, even through these times of Covid.

Though Yemen is one of the most dangerous countries to live in for Christians, they are seeing the greatest growth of the underground church in the Arabian peninsula. Thank God for this and pray for the Christian students in this country.

Thank God for all the students who are taking on responsibilities this year. Pray they'd grow in the faith and service, and that God would give wisdom to those who are following them.

friday

Pray students would align their priorities with God's priorities as they are motivated by the gospel and urged by the imminent return of Jesus!

Pray the GBU would persevere in discipleship, encouraging and equipping students in the faith for a life of godliness and mission (4th value of the GBU).

Pray for Alexandre and Sara (the current staff of GBU). Pray their family would be firmly built on the Rock, that God would keep them from the devil's attacks (from the inside and outside), and that they'd be good models for the students they serve.

Thank God for the opportunities students have had so far to share the good news of Jesus during the mission week. Pray God would continue his work in the heart of the students who heard the gospel.

saturday

Pray God would grow Christian students as disciples of Jesus during their studies (2nd goal of the GBU).

Pray people around us see us react distinctly to the current crisis, that they ask us the reasons for the hope that is in us, and that we would be ready to share the gospel with them faithfully, with gentleness, respect and a good conscience (1 P 3:14-16).

Pray for Christian students who feel alone and isolated in their faith. Pray they'd be able to join a GBU group and/or other believers in order to be encouraged and supported in the faith.

Pray that the GBU & its students would be resolved to be united around the essential truths of the gospel (5th value of the GBU).

sunday

Thank God for the faithful churches that the students are part of, and for the leaders He gave these churches to equip the saints for the work of ministry (Eph 4:11-16). Pray these churches take good care of them.

Pray for our church-leaders whose task of feeding the flock of God is made harder during this long period of crisis. May God give them wisdom, strength and joy, and pray they'd be workers who have no need to be ashamed (2 Tim 2:15).

In this time of unrest, pray for the Christian witness of our local churches, and of parachurch ministries such as GBU, UCCF, InterVarsity, and other students ministries around the world, as well as other parachurch missions such as Open Doors.

Thank God for the elders/pastors of your church. Pray God would sustain those who are facing particularly tough trials.
