monday

Pray that the GBU & its students remain founded on the word: that they'd seek to understand, celebrate and defend the truth of the gospel (1st value of the GBU).

Pray to God that non-believers come to our event MEET Life (evangelistic event). Pray they will be moved by what they hear and that they come back next semester (or at least keep considering the gospel).

Pray for tonight's LFEQ event (apologetics). That a defense of our hope in Christ may be presented clearly, with gentleness and respect (1 Pe 3:15).

Pray for believing students who often face the temptation to compromise themselves under various pressures. May God keep them faithful to Him and concerned with His own opinion rather than that of others, and that He sanctify them through His word.

Thank God for all the students who were involved at GBU this year. Pray God would continue to make them grow in the faith, and that they'd persevere in the mission wherever they find themselves next year.

tuesday

Pray that God would strengthen and motivate students by the gospel so that they proclaim it faithfully amongst their fellow students (1st goal of the GBU).

Pray for all the one-to-one Bible studies that will take place this week.

Pray the GBU would remain active in evangelism whilst proclaiming Christ crucified and resurrected faithfully, pertinently and attractively (3rd value of the GBU).

Pray that, motivated by grace, students would worship God for the gospel and that they'd love each other and the lost (2nd value of the GBU).

wednesday

In Bulgaria, IFES InterAction volunteer Alesia asks us to pray for conversations with international students, especially those from Muslim backgrounds, who are interested in Christianity.

Pray that the GBU & its students would be resolved to be united around the essential truths of the gospel (5th value of the GBU).

Give thanks for SONOKO Cambodia students sharing the gospel with friends through a swimming camp, movie night and personal evangelism.

Ask God for wisdom for IFES senior leaders as they make decisions in response to the constantly changing Coronavirus situation.

thursday

Thank God for all the opportunities the students had to share the good news of Jesus during the Week of events in Brussels and Liege (March 22-27). Please pray God would continue His work in the hearts of the students we spoke to (approximately 100).

Pray God would guide all things as various European student movements seek to employ new staff. Pray he sends capable gospel workers who have biblical convictions and the right character (consecrated and faithful to the gospel).

Pray the GBU & its students would always be dedicated to the local church which is the main place of growth and service of believers (6th value of the GBU).

Pray the GBU would persevere in discipleship, encouraging and equipping students in the faith for a life of godliness and mission (4th value of the GBU).

friday

Thank God for the support of the current Friends of GBU and pray new Friends would join the movement in order to support the GBU and see many students come to Christ and persevere in the faith & the mission.

Pray God would grow Christian students as disciples of Jesus during their studies (2nd goal of the GBU).

Pray God strengthens and continues to grow Christian students in the faith during the more intense period of exams.

Praise God for the freedom students in Liège have to proclaim the gospel to more than 45,000 students. Pray they'd be filled with God's love to talk about the only One who can offer justification, and that those who listen would trust in Christ alone (Gal. 2:21).

saturday

Pray God gives wisdom to the staff of GBU who will be approaching and training some new student-leaders for next year.

Pray for the GBU AGM which is taking place this evening. Pray God gives wisdom to the leaders and Friends of the GBU, that they'd be united around the mission, the vision and the values of the GBU, and that the decisions made would honour God.

Please pray for Alex and Sara Manlow who head up the GBU in French-speaking Belgium. Pray that God would strengthen them as a couple, as parents, and that their lives would be living sacrifices to God, in response to his mercies (Rom 12:1).

Pray for the GBU's interns who will be presenting exams next weeks: that they would be further encouraged, rooted in Christ & equipped for a life of service of God & his church.

Pray for the translation project of "Uncover Luke" on which staff and interns of GBU Belgium are working. Pray it would soon be available and that it may be useful to many Christians to help them reach out to others with the gospel.

sunday

Pray for the testimony of Christian students: that they would walk in a manner worthy of the gospel, distinct in their attachment to Christ (Eph 4:1).

Praise God that it's Sunday! Give thanks that there is something significant happening as God's people gather, as one body, united by the gospel, in submission to God's Word, for His glory.

Thank God for the elders/pastors of the churches students are part of, and pray they'd keep a close watch on themselves and the teaching. Pray students would not despise them, convinced of the importance of their work (1 Tm 4:12-16).

Pray that, all throughout the summer and next term, the students do not abandon their churches, given the key role each member has in the light of the coming judgement (Heb 10:23-31).

Thank God for the support students have from their brothers and sisters in their churches. Pray churches would invest more in them as they need to be encouraged in the truth in order to be firmly rooted in Christ and established in the faith (Col 2,6-7).

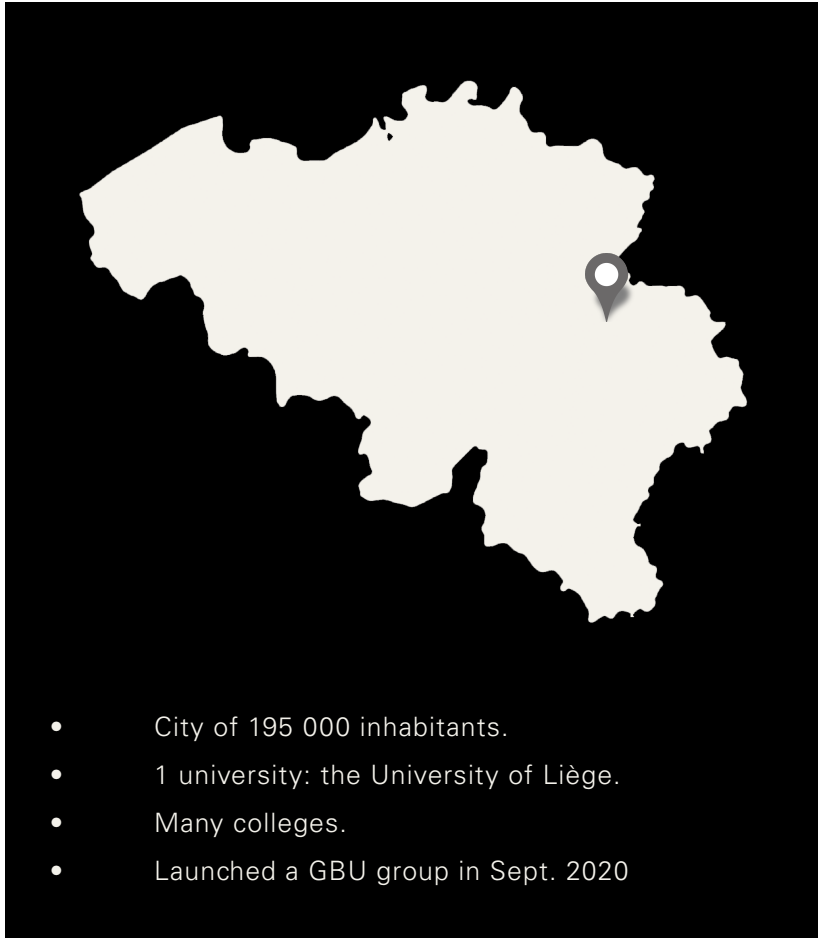
