monday

Pray the GBU & its students would always be dedicated to the local church which is the main place of growth and service of believers (6th value of the GBU).

Give thanks to God for the Bible studies in Galatians this year; pray for discernment as the students hear 'messages' that people say come from God but that aren't the gospel according to the Bible.

Pray for the students who have started enquiring about the gospel this year thanks to the work of student-ministries. Pray God would give them repentance and faith in Christ, and that they would join faithful local churches!

Pray that the GBU & its students remain founded on the word: that they'd seek to understand, celebrate and defend the truth of the gospel (1st value of the GBU).

tuesday

Pray God strengthens and continues to grow Christian students in the faith during the more intense period of exams.

Pray for the GBU's interns who will be presenting exams next weeks: that they would be further encouraged, rooted in Christ & equipped for a life of service of God & his church.

Pray the GBU would persevere in discipleship, encouraging and equipping students in the faith for a life of godliness and mission (4th value of the GBU).

Pray for all the summer camps organised by the European student movements. Pray these camps would be great opportunities of growth in the faith and of training students called to be disciple-making disciples.

Thank God for the good work of many European General Secretaries over many decades. Pray God would sustain them and make the students they serve persevere in the faith and in their mission of making Christ known to the lost.

wednesday

Pray that God would strengthen and motivate students by the gospel so that they proclaim it faithfully amongst their fellow students (1st goal of the GBU).

Thank God for the GBU's impact amongst students in french-speaking Belgium since it started and for all those people He used. Pray God continues to use the GBU in the areas of evangelism, edification and training of students in order to grow His kingdom.

Pray Christian students keep their conduct honorable before everyone during exams out of fear of God. Pray they'd work hard for God's glory, putting their studies into the perspective of eternity.

Praise God for Christ's resurrection that gives us a certain hope that means that our faith, our life lived out for Jesus and our outreach is not in vain, however difficult it may be (1 Co 15) !

Pray students would have a refreshing summer and that, during this time of rest, they'd continue to have their convictions fashioned by the Bible so that they'd walk more and more in a manner worthy of the Lord.

thursday

Pray the GBU would remain active in evangelism whilst proclaiming Christ crucified and resurrected faithfully, pertinently and attractively (3rd value of the GBU).

Thank God for the students who lead groups & all those involved in the GBU. Pray they would grow in the faith & in service, and pray that we can find new leaders for next term.

Pray that the students persevere in making Christ known to their friends, even during the more intense period at the end of the year.

Pray that the GBU & its students would be resolved to be united around the essential truths of the gospel (5th value of the GBU).

friday

Praise God for the freedom to share the gospel here. Pray students would make the most of it, strengthened by Him to share it with more than 170,000 non-Christian students who desperately need to hear and believe in the gospel.

Pray God would grow Christian students as disciples of Jesus during their studies (2nd goal of the GBU).

Pray Christian students would realise their primary vocation is to be a disciple of Jesus who makes other disciples (Mt 28:18-20), and that they would consider their future workplaces as places where they're called to carry out their primary vocation.

Pray many freshers starting their studies in September would hear about the GBU, and that more students would benefit from our ministry so that they would continue to persevere in the faith and in their mission as disciple-making disciples.

saturday

Thank God for the new Friends who recently joined the GBU. Pray for this new partnership and that more believers would commit themselves to support this key ministry in favour of students.

Pray for the students of Belgium: that many believers would invest in the GBUs to support and be supported in their mission as disciples of Christ who are called to make disciple in the student world.

Pray that, motivated by grace, students would worship God for the gospel and that they'd love each other and the lost (2nd value of the GBU).

Thank God for all the students who were involved at GBU this year. Pray God would continue to make them grow in the faith, and that they'd persevere in the mission wherever they find themselves next year.

sunday

Thank God for the support students have from their brothers and sisters in their churches. Pray churches would invest more in them as they need to be encouraged in the truth in order to be firmly rooted in Christ and established in the faith.

Pray Christian students would rejoice in being part of the church, the Body of Christ, and would be committed to it, especially during exams, knowing they are members who are called to serve the Body and its members (1 Co 12).

Thank God for the faithful churches that the students are part of, and for the leaders He gave these churches to equip the saints for the work of ministry (Eph 4:11-16). Pray these churches take good care of them.

Pray that, all throughout the summer and next term, the students do not abandon their churches, given the key role each member has in the light of the coming judgement (Heb 10:23-31).

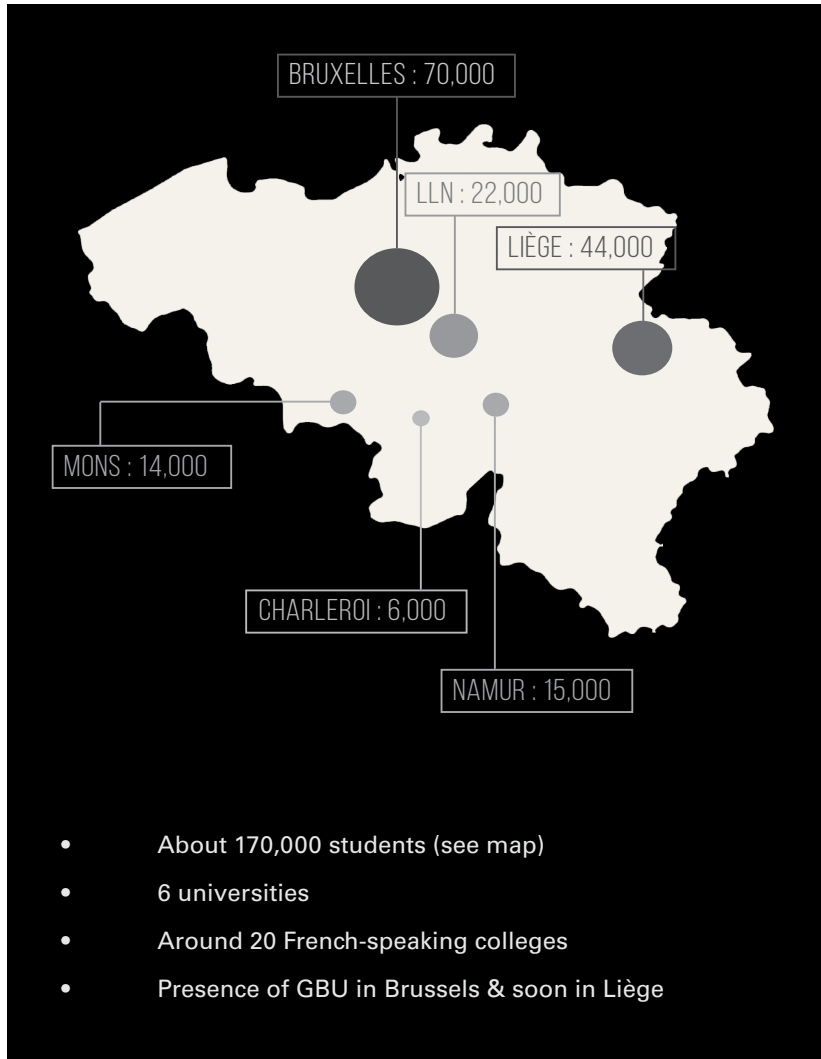
